**TEMPORARY CLOSING OF PUBLIC ROAD**  
Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Article 12 of the Roads Regulations, 1994, that Cork County Council, the Road Authority for the County of Cork, is considering, pursuant to Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993, the temporary closure of the public road as detailed below, for the period and for the reason specified and that the alternative route described below would be available while the road is temporarily closed.

**Road Subject of Closure:**  
N25 Youghal By-Pass, westbound between Junction for Youghal (R634) and N25/R634 Junction. The N25 eastbound will remain open for the duration of the works with traffic management in place which will reduce the lane width.

From 09.00hrs - 16.00hrs Monday, 12th August to Friday, 16th August 2019 inclusive.

**Reason:**  
To facilitate the repair of the Vehicle Restraint System in the central reserve and in the interest of public safety.

**Notice of Direct Planning Application to An Bord Pleanála for Approval in Respect of a Strategic Infrastructure Development (a proposed Electricity Transmission Development)**  
**Kildare County Council and Meath County Council.**

In accordance with Section 182A of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended), EirGrid plc, with the consent and approval of the Electricity Supply Board (ESB), gives notice of its intention to seek the Approval of An Bord Pleanála in relation to a proposed electricity transmission infrastructure development, and associated works, in the townlands of Ravensdale, Kellystown, Blakestown (North Salt By) and Leixlip in County Kildare, and Bogganstown in County Meath. The proposed development will consist of:

i. A 220 kV Gas Insulated Switchgear (GIS) substation, primarily contained within a building with a gross floor area of approximately 2,462 square metres and a height of approximately 17 metres. The substation will be sited within an area of approximately 8,420 square metres located in the townland of Kellystown, Co. Kildare. Associated development within the substation compound will include: a lattice steel communications tower of approximately 36 metres in height; 6 lightning rods of approximately 3 metres in height located on the parapet of the GIS building; a Distribution System Operator (DSO) compound (approximately 25 square metres); interface kiosks; an access road of approximately 35 metres in length and 5 metres in width with a new entrance onto the L1015 - Confey Road; ancillary car parking; and all associated site development and landscaping works. The substation compound will be bounded by a palisade fence 2.6 metres in height and bounded within a property fence 1.4m in height;

ii. Installation of two 220 kV underground cable (UGC) circuits connecting the existing Maynooth to Woodland 220 kV overhead line (OHL) in the townland of Bogganstown Co. Meath to the proposed 220 kV GIS substation. Each UGC circuit is approximately 2.3 kilometres in length. The UGC circuits will be constructed through agricultural lands in the townlands of Bogganstown Co. Meath, and Ravensdale and Kellystown Co. Kildare, before crossing under the existing local road (L1015 - Confey Road) to connect into the proposed 220 kV GIS substation; associated development includes the provision of 8 no. underground joint bays, and the provision, upgrading and/or extension of existing internal access tracks in the townlands of Bogganstown, Co. Meath and Ravensdale Co. Kildare to provide operational vehicular access to the proposed development;

iii. The construction of two Line Cable Interface Masts (LCIMs) of approximately 26.5 metres in height in the townland of Bogganstown Co. Meath, comprising the points of transition from the existing OHL to the proposed UGC. This will facilitate the proposed removal of a section of existing OHL (approximately 130 metres);

iv. Refurbishment of an existing OHL angle tower (reference AM37) located in the townland of Bogganstown, Co. Meath, comprising recapping of shear blocks and other maintenance works to apparatus;

v. The installation of seven bores and associated cable trenches and ancillary equipment connecting the proposed 220 kV GIS substation to the demand customer transformers at the Intel Ireland Limited facility, in the townlands of Kellystown, Blakestown and Leixlip, Co. Kildare. These bores and associated trenches (each approximately 400m in length), will occur adjacent to, and under, the Rye Water Valley / Carton Special Area of Conservation. These bores and trenches will facilitate the installation of up to six 220 kV circuits and associated low voltage and communication cabling;

vi. All associated and ancillary development including temporary construction compounds adjacent to the proposed 220 kV GIS substation in the townland of Kellystown, Co. Kildare and in proximity to the LCIMs and UGC alignment in the townland of Bogganstown Co. Meath; and temporary construction tracks from the proposed development sites onto the R157 and the L1015 - Confey Road.

The proposed development includes the carrying out of works within the curtilage of a protected structure - Ravensdale House and Gate House (Kildare Register of Protected Structures ref. B06-08).

A Natura Impact Statement (Stage 2 Appropriate Assessment) has been prepared in respect of this application for Approval.
